How do we compare to other schools



Over the last 5 years, we have been consistently ranked **in the top 25% of schools nationally** for A Level and BTEC results.

Last year 13s achieved

- **61% of grades at A* to B (top 15% of schools nationally)**
- **84% achieved at A* to C (top 18% of schools nationally).**

This has allowed our students to go to the most prestigious universities in the UK.

On average, over the last 5 years, **22% of of Harrow High Students go to Russell Group Universities compared to the national average of 12%**

Why a smaller Sixth Form

- ❑ A smaller number of subjects ...
- ❑ Consequently the number of lessons per week is increased
- ❑ Smaller class sizes (10-15 students)
- ❑ Timetabling is different:
 - ❑ Extra Study Periods for Interleaving
 - ❑ Personal Development
 - ❑ Study leave during exam season



Maths at HHS

- ALPS 2 - **top 10%** of Maths departments nationally for progress.
- At HHS, year 13 A level Maths students with a:
 - Grade 9 are more likely to achieve an A*
 - Grade 7 are twice as likely to achieve an A
 - Grade 6 are twice as likely to achieve a C

How have we achieved this?

- Small, dedicated team of experienced specialists.
- Department intervention tutor offering two additional periods per week for support.
- Use of online platforms like UpLearn and Dr Frost.
- High standards of teaching and high quality resources.
- Small class sizes for more personalised support.

Looking forward

- Implement Further Maths A Level to be taught by our most experienced staff members with a small teaching group. This can be taken as a third or fourth A Level.
- Continue to improve on our fantastic results.






