Spelling rules for verbs in "ing" form

BASE FORM	"ING" - FORM
Work - Catch - Sleep	Work ing - Catch ing - Sleep ing
Study - Play - Buy	Stud ying - Play ing - Buy ing Final letter "y" is in the same place
Go - Do	Go ing - Do ing
Write - Take - Drive	Writ ing - Tak ing - Driv ing Final letter "e" is eliminated
Lay - Lie	L ying - L ying (Yes, equal!)
Swim* - Run* - Stop*	Swim ming - Run ning - Stop ping

* The final three letters are "consonant - vowel - consonant" that's why we have double consonant "mm - nn - pp"

Will in the Future Tense: **Section B**

Future Tense: Will → Form

Affirmative: I **will** travel to Madrid in October.

Interrogative: **Will** you travel by bus?

Negative: I **will not** travel - **won't**

Will you travel by train or by bus?
I **won't** travel by bus I **will** probably travel by train

More writing: Next summer
