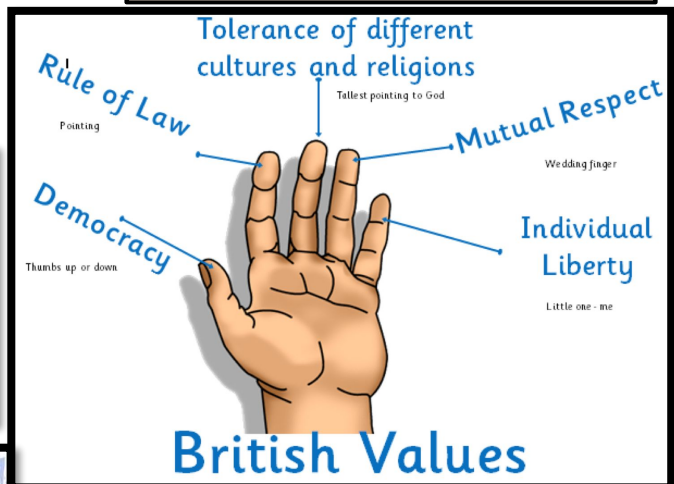




Section A – British Values



• The rule of the law
