We add -ed in all persons.

talk-talked
play-played

We have to study them as they have special forms in the past.

eat-ate
speak-spoke
have-had

Infinitive	Past Tense	Negative
to be	was were	was not were not
to have	had	did not have
to do	did	did not do
to say	said	did not say
to get	got	did not get
to make	made	did not make
to go	went	did not go
to take	took	did not take
to see	saw	did not see
to come	came	did not come

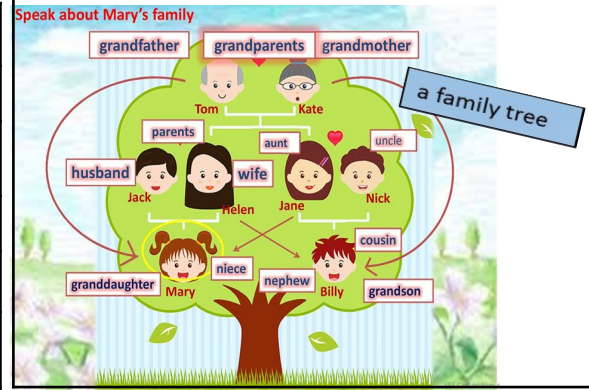

Regular verbs: **Section C**

Spelling rules	Examples
base form + ed	walk → walked play → played
verbs ending in -e + d	like → liked move → moved
verbs ending in a consonant + y	carry → carried study → studied
change y → i + ed	
Some verbs ending in a single consonant + the second last letter is a vowel	plan → planned stop → stopped
→ double the last letter + ed	

Family Key Vocabulary: **Section D**

KEY WORD	SYNONYMS/DEFINITION
RELATIVE	a member of a family
SIBLING	a brother or a sister
PARENT	A mother or a father
GRANDPARENT	a grandmother of a grandfather
NIECE	daughter of one's brother or sister
SON	a father or a mother's boy
DAUGHTER	a father or a mother's girl
NEPHEW	son of one's brother or sister
SPOUSE	a husband or a wife
DIVORCED	when a husband and wife get formally separated
CHILDHOOD	the period of being a child
