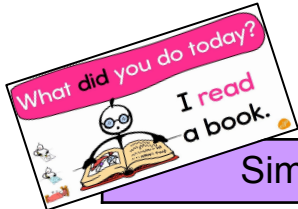

Past	Present	Future
Past simple (commonly called simple past)	Present simple (commonly called simple present)	Future simple (commonly called simple future)
<i>The dog <u>was</u> sick</i> <i>It <u>rained</u> (yesterday)</i>	<i>The dog <u>is</u> sick</i> <i>It <u>rains</u> (every day)</i>	<i>The dog <u>will be</u> sick</i> <i>It <u>will</u> rain (tomorrow)</i>
<i>She (just) <u>went</u> to the market</i>	<i>She <u>goes</u> to the market (as usual)</i>	<i>She <u>will go</u> to the market (soon)</i>

Her time at college was the most eventful period of her life.

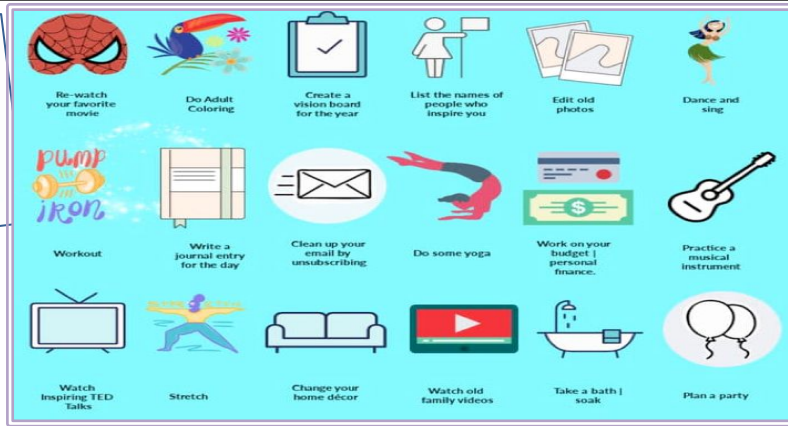
Substantial
