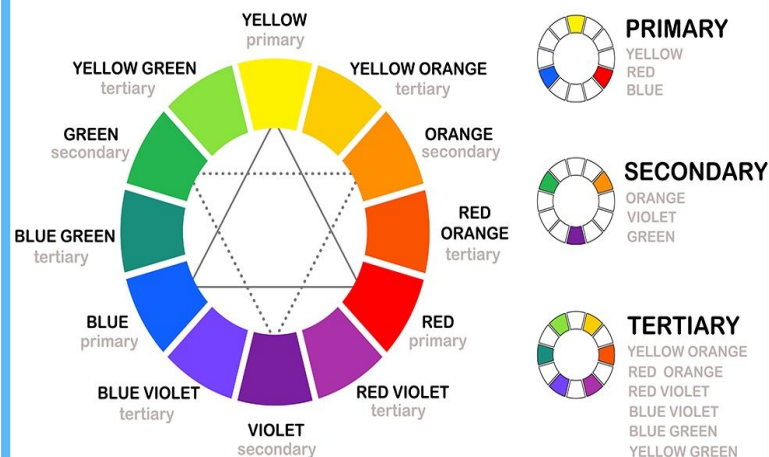


A. Colour Theory

Primary = Red : Yellow :Blue	Complementary = colours opposite on the colour wheel
Secondary = Primary +Primary	Harmonious = colours next to each other on the wheel
Tertiary = Secondary +Primary	Monochromatic = shades and tints of one colour
Shade = + black	Hue= pigments
Tint =+ white	Warm colours = Red, Yellow and orange Cold colours = Blue, Green and purple.

Word	Meaning
Observational	watching something closely
Reflection	Light through glass
Refraction	The bending of light as it passes from one transparent substances
Monochrome	Various shades or tints of one colour
Studies	A detailed drawing or painting of an object/s
Harmony	A pleasing arrangement

D. Key words

Media	The substance that artist use to make and create a piece of art work
Materials	The same as media but can also refer to the basis of art work e.g. canvas, paper or clay
Processes	The method used to create artwork that usually follows a range of steps rather than just skill.
Techniques	The method used to complete the artwork, can be generic such as painting or more focus such as blending.
