

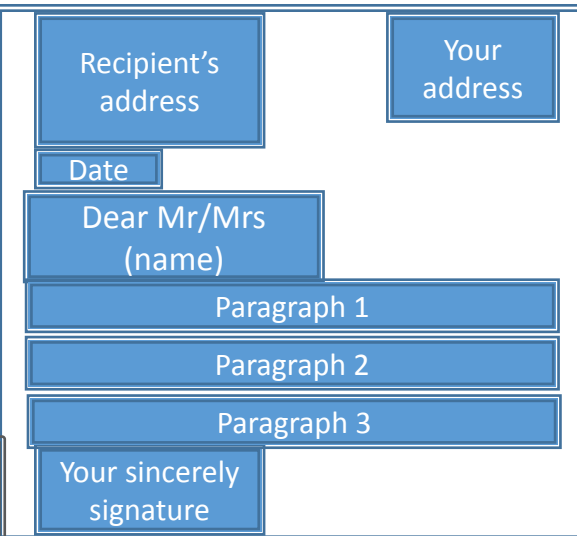
## Section A – Wild Carpathia - Key Vocabulary

<b>DESTITUTE</b> ✓	extremely poor and lacking the means to provide for oneself.	<b>MALNUTRITION</b> ✓	lack of proper nutrition, caused by not having enough to eat.
<b>HARDSHIP</b> ✓	severe suffering; poverty; deprivation.	<b>RESORT</b> ✓	utilize; make use of; turn to.
<b>VOLUNTEER</b> ✓	a person who works for an organization without being paid.	<b>AFFLUENT</b> ✓	well off; rich; wealthy.
<b>DEPRIVED</b> ✓	impoverished; disadvantaged.	<b>IMPOVERISHMENT</b> ✓	the process of becoming poor; loss of wealth.
<b>DEVELOPING (country)</b> ✓	growing and becoming more advanced economically and socially.	<b>DONATION</b> ✓	contribution, something that is given to a charity, especially a sum of money.
<b>HOMELESS</b> ✓	one the streets; vagrant; living rough.	<b>MAKE ENDS MEET</b> ✓	earn just enough money to live on.

<u>Fantastic</u>	Wonderful, awesome, fabulous, marvelous
<u>Fascinating</u>	Very interesting, captivating, intriguing
<u>Huge</u>	Enormous, giant, sprawling, vast
<u>Lively</u>	Somewhere with lots of thing going on, vibrant
<u>Inexpensive</u>	Not costing very much, cheap
<u>Popular</u>	Liked by a lot of people
<u>Picturesque</u>	Interesting in a unique way, charming, quaint
<u>Touristy</u>	Visited by lots of tourists
