Our Curriculum:

- **Key Stage 3:** A broad curriculum is followed including English and Maths, all three sciences, two Modern Foreign Languages, History and Geography, alongside Computer Science, Food Technology, Music, Design & Technology, Art, Drama, PE and Philosophy, Religion and Ethics.
- **Key Stage 4:** All learners follow an ambitious combination of GCSE subjects, tailored to their own needs and interests leading to excellent outcomes. The core offering of Maths, English Language & Literature, all three sciences and Religious Studies is supplemented by a wide range of option choices.
- **Sixth Form:** A wide range of A-Levels in which learners consistently excel alongside two very successful BTEC programmes.

We are fortunate to have a dedicated Counsellor and City Year mentors who work alongside our pastoral teams to provide invaluable support to individual learners across the school.

- **Aspirations Trips:** Every learner participates in at least three cultural trips each year to places like museums, London landmarks, and theatres.
- **University Visits:** Every learner visits at least two universities, starting in Year 7, to help them plan for their future.
- **Work Experience:** In Year 10, all learners gain valuable work experience, providing a crucial first look into the professional world.
- **Careers Programme:**
We provide multiple opportunities for learners to explore career paths and the qualifications needed to succeed.

Beyond our clubs, we offer unique opportunities that challenge and inspire:

- **CCF (Combined Cadet Force):** In Year 10, some learners join the CCF, taking part in activities in partnership with Harrow School.
- **The Duke of Edinburgh Award:** Exceptional learners can complete the Duke of Edinburgh Award, with some achieving the prestigious Gold Award.
- **Medical Society:** Run in conjunction with King's College London, is a club which runs in the Sixth Form, to support learners who would like to work in the medical field as Doctors, Dentists, and Pharmacists. Students debate topical healthcare issues, visit King's College Medical school, and are supported in making successful applications to prestigious universities. In recent years our members have gone onto study Medicine at universities such as Cambridge, Imperial, and Birmingham.

We consistently rank among the top schools nationally for the progress our learners make, reflecting the significant value we add to their academic journey.

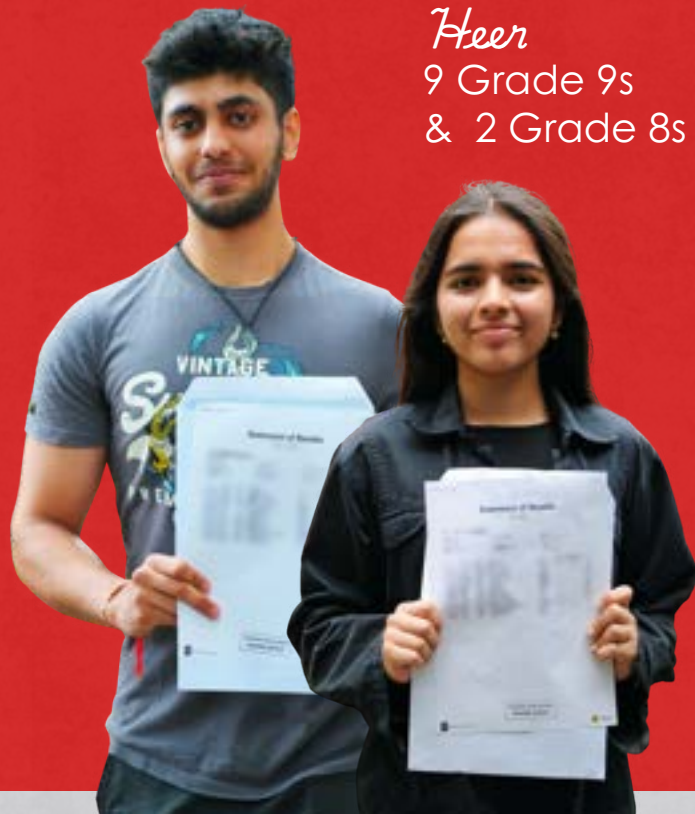

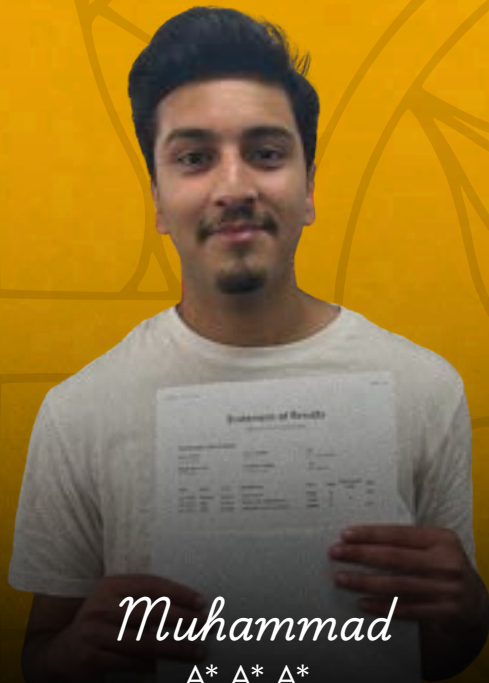

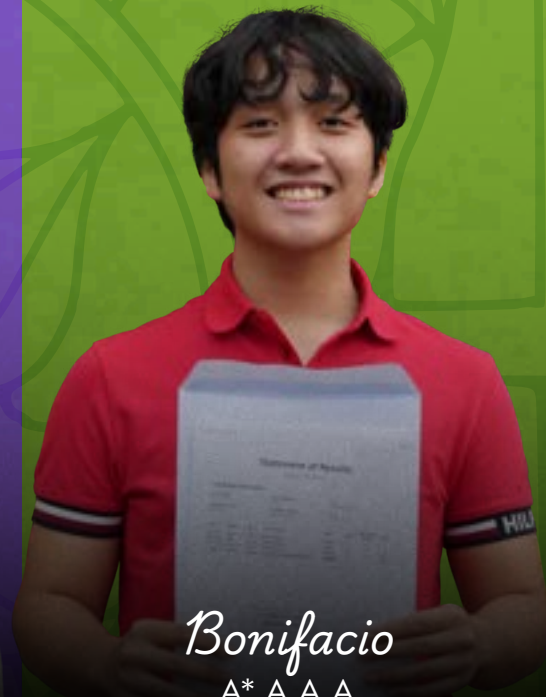
