<b>Career</b>	An occupation undertaken for a significant period of a person's life and with opportunities for progress	<b>Labour Market</b>	Labour Market Information (LMI) provides statistics, research and analysis about current and future economic and job trends	<b>Progression</b>	The process of developing or moving gradually towards a more advanced state	<b>Professional</b>	A member of a profession or any person who earns a living from a specified professional activity.
